Should you be at school?

Children should be at home if they have any of the following symptoms of illness...



Fever and chills (greater than 37.5 degrees Celsius)



Coughing and Sneezing



Vomiting or Nausea



Extreme Exhaustion



Shortness of Breath



Close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19



Diarrhea



Severe Headache



Difficulty breathing (and seek medical assistance)



Loss of taste or smell

Also, pre-existing medical conditions until you have medical clearance

(for example Heart Disease, Lung Disease, Kidney Disease, Asthma, Diabetes, Cancer, Immunocompromised etc.)

Volunteering / Criminal Record Checks

Our school board policy has been tightened so that we need two things from you if you volunteer or attend field trips, drive students to sporting events, etc.

- 1. We need you to fill out a Volunteer Registration Form. Kate has this form at the office.
- 2. We need you to have a **criminal records check completed**. This is a free service and is valid for 5 years. It is unique to SD83, and is kept on record at our district office (so if you have children at multiple schools or when your child moves on, we have it on record).
- 3. If driving students, we will need a copy of your driver's license, insurance papers, and driver's abstract.

Thank you for your support with this. It is very important that we have all the correct information in case we need to contact parents in emergency situations and so we can keep you up to date!


Breakfast Program and Snacks

Learning Updates, formerly known as Report Cards, will begin with in-person conferences on October 17th, 2024. Written learning updates will be sent home on December 11th, 2024, and March 5th, 2025. Student-led conferences will occur sometime between April 28th and May 9th, 2025. The final learning update is sent home the last day of school on June 26th, 2025.

If you have questions regarding your child's progress, please contact your child's teacher any time. The sooner the better so that student, teacher, and parent can all be on the same page for success!

Please Leave at Home

A reminder to all students and parents that the following items should not be brought to school:

- cameras, cell phones, tablets, smartwatches
- toys or electronics
- pocket money
- wheeled shoes (wheelies or heely's) or rollerblades
- knives or toy weapons
- lighters or matches
- laser pointers
- spray deodorants
- slime toys and modeling clay
- items that distract your child or others from learning

This is for the safety of all and to avoid situations where items could get broken or go missing.
